## **Encore Assists Organization with MU Audit Readiness**

#### **CHALLENGE**

This organization had worked with their Electronic Medical Record provider to prepare for Meaningful Use (MU) attestation. It was aware that MU audits are common and wanted to prepare their staff for that possible event. The organization felt that the evaluation by an outside party would highlight possible problem areas in an audit and would allow them to save time and money by pro-actively remediating any identified issues.

#### **ENCORE'S APPROACH AND SOLUTION**

Dedicated to providing service that meets our customer's needs, Encore delivered a focused workshop/assessment to support the organization in their preparations for potential audits of their MU program by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) and the Office of the Inspector General. The workshop was conducted in two parts. The first included a self-assessment of the organization's MU vision, culture, governance, evidence collection and associated Audit Defense Plan. The second part focused on preparing the organization to meet the specific requirements of the Incentive Program and included an in-depth review of the CMS Audit Program; an Audit Case Study; a review of the organization's specific roles and responsibilities related to a potential Audit; information on how to design and store auditable defense evidence; a detailed review of data and documentation related to particularly difficult measures and an open question/answer session to address specific concerns.

#### **RESULTS**

The final report was delivered in a virtual session. Encore's entire engagement lasted two weeks and delivered excellent value, including a report that did more than highlight areas of concern. The report supplied specific recommendations related to CDS, report filter configuration, Security Risk Assessment practice and documentation, the regulatory aspects of CPOE and creating an actionable Audit Plan that would ensure an immediate response. Additionally, Encore validated many of the organization's current practices related to leadership engagement and support, researching measure requirements, documenting decisions and overall MU governance.
